

ORDINANCE NO. 07-689

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA, ADOPTING "TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY AMENDMENTS TO THE 2006 INTERNATIONAL CODE COUNCIL CODES AND THE 2005 NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE" BY REFERENCE.

WHEREAS, the Council adopted the 2006 International Code Council Codes and the 2005 National Electrical Code; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Chino Valley desire to amend said codes to protect the health and safety of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires that this ordinance shall become operative and in force on July 1, 2007;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Chino Valley, County of Yavapai, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1. That certain document known as the "Town of Chino Valley Amendments to the 2006 International Code Council Codes and 2005 National Electrical Code", three copies of which are on file in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Chino Valley, Yavapai County, Arizona, which document was made a public record by Resolution No. 07-837 of the Town of Chino Valley, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this Ordinance.

Section 2. All other sections of the Town Code, other ordinances, and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed on the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Any person found guilty of violating any provision of this Building Code shall be deemed guilty of a class 3 misdemeanor. Each day such violation is committed or permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such hereunder.

Section 4. The amendment of these sections of the Town code do not affect the rights and duties that have matured and/or the penalties that were incurred hereunder and /or any proceedings that were begun before the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance or any part of the Building Code adopted herein by reference, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 6. The provisions of this ordinance shall become operative and in force on July 1, 2007.
