**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND
COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO
VALLEY, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA,
SUPPORTING THE STATE OF ARIZONA
GOVERNORS OFFICE OF ENERGY POLICY
GRANT APPLICATION NUMBER RFGA EW-
ESA-12-2212-00.**

WHEREAS, the primary mission of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act – Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant EECBG program is to assist, coordinate, and collaborate with eligible local government entities in applying for the established allocation and implementing project focused on increasing energy efficiency, reducing energy use, job creation, and reducing fossil fuel emissions; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Chino Valley has been investigating the concepts of renewable energy, water sustainability, and conservation projects; and

WHEREAS, the Town has already been awarded approximately \$187,000 in grant funding for the renewable energy pilot project at its Waste Water Reclamation Facility; and

WHEREAS, the Town is currently investigating an expansion of the renewable energy pilot project at its Waste Water Reclamation Facility to continue to offset energy costs; and

WHEREAS, the Town will utilize the established allocation of EECBG funds for an eligible activity and fulfill the requirements, terms, and conditions of the contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Chino Valley, Arizona as follows:

The Town of Chino Valley, in Yavapai County, Arizona, hereby acknowledges and authorizes the filing of the solicitation of Grant Application Number RFGA EW-ESA-12-2213-00 through the Arizona Governors Office of Energy Policy Grant Application for the Conservation Block Grant program for its competitive funding allocation.
