

RESOLUTION NO. 12-986

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA, ADOPTING THE YAVAPAI COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN 2011; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL ACCORDING TO LAW

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (“DMA2K”) requires adoption and periodic updating of county disaster mitigation plans as a condition of mitigation grant assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Chino Valley (“Town”) has participated with Yavapai County (“County”) as part of the Yavapai County Multi-Jurisdictional Planning Team to develop the 2011 update to the Yavapai County Multi-Jurisdictional Mitigation Plan (“Plan”); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Plan is to identify natural and human caused hazards (i.e. flooding, land/mudslides, severe wind, wildfire, and winter storms resulting in damage to and/or loss of property and life, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety) that may affect the Town, assess the vulnerability and risk posed by those hazards to community-wide human and structural assets, and develop strategies for mitigation of those identified hazards; and

WHEREAS, approval of the Plan by the Town and other public entities within the County, and approval from the Arizona Division of Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency, will allow the Town to apply for federal mitigation grant funding;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, ARIZONA, THAT:

1. The Yavapai County Multi-Jurisdictional Mitigation Plan 2011, on file and available in the office of the Chino Valley Town Clerk, be hereby approved and adopted by Chino Valley.

2. This Resolution shall be effective after its passage and approval according to law.
