

**RESOLUTION NO. 12-988**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, PERTAINING TO THE SUBMISSION OF PROJECTS FOR CONSIDERATION IN ARIZONA'S 2013 HIGHWAY SAFETY PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, the Governor's Office of Highway Safety is seeking proposals from state and local agencies for projects relating to all aspects of highway safety; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Chino Valley, through the Police Department, is interested in submitting a project to be considered for funding encompassing the areas of DUI enforcement and speed enforcement to request funds for DUI enforcement overtime and purchase of six "speed checked by radar" street signs;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Council of the Town of Chino Valley hereby grant approval for the submission of projects for consideration in Arizona's 2013 Highway Safety Plan.

Section 2. That the Chief of Police is appointed as agent for the Town of Chino Valley, to conduct all negotiations and to execute and submit all documents and any other necessary or desirable instruments in connection with such grant.
