

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-956**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, ARIZONA, SUPPORTING A FINDING IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST FOR THE HIGHWAY 89 TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined by the Federal Highways Administration (FHWA) and the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) that the use of proprietary services requires a "Finding in the Public Interest;" and

**WHEREAS**, a local artist who is proficient in full scale bronze sculpting of equine exists here in Chino Valley; and

**WHEREAS**, it is appropriate and necessary for the Town Council of Chino Valley to provide this endorsement of a "Finding in the Public Interest" that will allow FHWA and ADOT to deem that Diana Simpson of Chino Valley is the proprietary artist necessary to successfully complete this sculpting;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Chino Valley, Arizona, as follows:

1. The Council of the Town of Chino Valley fully endorses the finding in the public interest to use Diana Simpson as a proprietary service for the development of three full scale bronze sculpting of horses per the developed model entitled "Proud Heritage."
