

RESOLUTION NO. 11-965

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, ADOPTING AN EXPENDITURE LIMITATION TO GOVERN THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2011/2012, DECLARING THAT THE SAME SHALL CONSTITUTE THE BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL ACCORDING TO THE LAW

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 9, Section 20(9) of the Arizona Constitution, and ARS Section 41-563.03(C), (E) and (G), the qualified voters of the Town of Chino Valley did, on March 10, 2009, adopt an Alternative Expenditure Limitation for the Town; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 400, which set forth said Alternative Expenditure Limitation, provided that, as part of the budget process, the Mayor and Common Council shall annually adopt an expenditure limitation to govern the budget, after public hearing; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Title 42, Chapter 17, Articles 1-5, Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.), the City/Town Council did, on July 12, 2011 make an estimate of the different amounts required to meet the public expenditures/expenses for the ensuing year, also an estimate of revenues from sources other than direct taxation, and the amount to be raised by taxation upon real and personal property of the Town of Chino Valley; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with said chapter of said title, and following due public notice, the Council met on August 9, 2011, at which meeting any taxpayer was privileged to appear and be heard in favor of or against any of the proposed expenditures/expenses or tax levies; and

WHEREAS, it appears that publication has been duly made as required by law, of said estimates not to exceed \$16,608,231, together with a Public Notice that the Town Council would meet on August 9, 2011, in the Town's Council Chambers for the purpose of hearing any and all citizens who wish to speak in favor of or against any of the proposed expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council desire now to establish an expenditure limitation and budget expenditures for Fiscal Year 2011-2012, which expenditures do not exceed the published tentative budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Chino Valley, County of Yavapai, Arizona, as follows:

1. That the expenditure limitation to govern the Town of Chino Valley budget for Fiscal Year 2011-2012 is hereby established in an amount not to exceed **\$16,589,845**.
2. That the estimates of revenues and expenditures shown in the schedules attached hereto and expressly made a part hereof, are hereby adopted as the budget of the Town of Chino Valley for Fiscal Year 2011-2012.
3. That this Resolution shall be effective from and after its passage and approval according to law.
