

RESOLUTION NO. 11-954

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, PERTAINING TO THE SUBMISSION OF PROJECTS FOR CONSIDERATION IN ARIZONA'S 2012 HIGHWAY SAFETY PLAN

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Highway Safety is seeking proposals from state and local agencies for projects relating to all aspects of highway safety; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Chino Valley, through the Police Department, is interested in submitting a project to be considered for funding encompassing the areas of DUI enforcement, speed enforcement, and traffic records management. The Department is requesting funds for DUI enforcement overtime, purchase of two portable breath test devices, two Stalker II handheld radar devices, Pro Laser III speed detection device assigned to traffic motorcycle, and a Motorola eCitation device, with printer and software, for paperless records management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Council of the Town of Chino Valley hereby grant approval for the submission of projects for consideration in Arizona's 2012 Highway Safety Plan.

Section 2. That the Chief of Police is appointed agent for the Town of Chino Valley, to conduct all negotiations and to execute and submit all documents and any other necessary or desirable instruments in connection with such grant.
