

RESOLUTION NO. 11-972

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA, ESTABLISHING A MAYOR'S AD HOC WATER STEWARDSHIP COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Mayor desires to establish a committee to research methods and opportunities for water conservation, aquifer recharge, and rain harvesting in order to preserve the Town's natural resources;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Chino Valley, Arizona, as follows:

- 1) A Mayor's Ad Hoc Water Stewardship Committee is hereby established to research methods and opportunities for water conservation, aquifer recharge, and rain harvesting in order to preserve the Town's natural resources.
- 2) Results of the Committee's research will be reported to the Town Council.
- 3) The Committee will be comprised of the Mayor and four members of the community. The Mayor will be the Chair the Committee.
- 4) Committee meetings will be held once per month and Committee members will select a regular meeting day and time at their initial meeting.
