

RESOLUTION NO. 10-935

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA, SUPPORTING THE ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND CONSERVATION BLOCK GRANT BY FULFILLING THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE REQUEST FOR INFORMATION PROCESS THROUGH THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AS A QUALIFYING NON-DIRECT COMMUNITY THAT IS ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING

WHEREAS, the primary mission of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act – Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant EECBG program is to assist, coordinate, and collaborate with eligible local government entities in applying for the established allocation and implementing project focused on increasing energy efficiency, reducing energy use, and reducing fossil fuel emissions and job creation; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Chino Valley has been investigating the concepts of renewable energy, water sustainability, and conservation projects due to very limited natural resources within its region; and

WHEREAS, the Town has already been awarded a \$91,000 grant for the renewable energy pilot project at its Water Reclamation Facility; and

WHEREAS, the Town is currently investigating an expansion of the renewable energy pilot project at its Water Reclamation Facility to continue to offset energy costs; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to educate, promote, and demonstrate renewable energy throughout the community and lead by example; and

WHEREAS, the Town will utilize the established allocation of EECBG funds for an eligible activity and fulfill the requirements, terms, and conditions of the contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Chino Valley, Arizona as follows:

The Town of Chino Valley, in Yavapai County, Arizona, hereby acknowledges and authorizes the filling of the Solicitation of Grant Number G032-10 through the Arizona Department of Commerce Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant program for its competitive funding allocation.
