

RESOLUTION NO. 10-930

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, PERTAINING TO THE SUBMISSION OF PROJECTS FOR CONSIDERATION IN ARIZONA'S 2011 HIGHWAY SAFETY PLAN

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Highway Safety is seeking proposals from state and local agencies for projects relating to all aspects of highway safety; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Chino Valley, through the Police Department, is interested in submitting a project to be considered for funding encompassing the purchase of a fully-equipped and marked Chevy Tahoe police traffic enforcement vehicle, a fixed radar measurement device, four Stalker handheld radar devices, a Pro-Laser speed detection device, radar instructor training, overtime funds for an off-duty selective traffic enforcement program to aid in enforcing speed, seatbelt/child restraint, and overtime funds for DUI enforcement with the Tri-City Holiday DUI Taskforce.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Council of the Town of Chino Valley hereby grant approval for the submission of projects for consideration in Arizona's 2011 Highway Safety Plan.

Section 2. That the Chief of Police is appointed agent for the Town of Chino Valley, to conduct all negotiations and to execute and submit all documents and any other necessary or desirable instruments in connection with such grant.
