

RESOLUTION NO. 15-1069

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE ARIZONA GAME AND FISH DEPARTMENT FOR A SHOOTING RANGE DEVELOPMENT GRANT RELATED TO SHOOTING RANGE IMPROVEMENTS AT AND NEAR THE EXISTING SHOOTING RANGE

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Chino Valley desires to improve the economy of the community by creating jobs through economic development; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that the property located on what is known as Shooting Range Road would be an ideal location for additional shooting range activities; and

WHEREAS, construction and operation of a trap shooting range would be of public benefit by educating members and non-members of sportsmen's clubs about gun safety, as well as the benefit to wildlife and environmental management; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Chino Valley intends to construct a trap shooting range with grant funds and, upon final acceptance by the Town, to maintain said equipment and ranges in perpetuity;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Chino Valley, County of Yavapai, Arizona:

1. That it hereby authorizes submission of a grant application to the Arizona Department of Game and Fish for a shooting range development grant for the purpose of construction and operation of a trap shooting facility; and

2. That it authorizes the Mayor and, in the Mayor's absence the Vice Mayor, to execute all documents reasonably necessary for submission of the grant application; and

3. That it agrees to construct said improvements if the funding is made available and, upon final acceptance of the equipment by the Town, to accept the equipment and maintain it in perpetuity.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that is any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.


