

**RESOLUTION NO. 17-1100**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI AND STATE OF ARIZONA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 08-862, BY AMENDING SECTION 2 PURPOSE OF PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD, RELATED TO INCLUDING ASSISTANCE TO TOWN STAFF AND EVENT PLANNING AND FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Council adopted Resolution No. 08-862 on January 24, 2008, ratifying the creation of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board (the "Board") and setting forth its purpose, membership, duties, responsibilities and procedures; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council desires to revise the purpose of the Board to include assisting Town Staff in planning Town events;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Chino Valley, in the County of Yavapai and State of Arizona as follows:

1. Resolution No. 8-862 is hereby amended by amending Section 2: Purpose of Parks and Recreation Advisory Board to read as follows (additions shown in ALL CAPS; deletions shown in strikethrough):

Section 2: Purpose of Parks and Recreation Advisory Board

The purpose of the Chino Valley Parks and Recreation Advisory Board ("Board") is as follows:

- A. To advise the Mayor and Common Council regarding Parks and Recreation policies, programs, services and facilities.
- B. To make recommendations to the Mayor and Common Council regarding Parks and Recreation budget matters.
- C. To present to the Mayor and Common Council during a regularly scheduled Town Council meeting in July an Annual Report describing the accomplishments of the Advisory Board in the previous year and plans for the next year.
- D. TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO TOWN STAFF, AS AUTHORIZED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL IN PLANNING TOWN-SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENTS AND FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of

any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.
