

RESOLUTION NO. 18-1132

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA, NAMING CERTAIN TOWN FACILITIES AS THE DARLENE J. WESTCOTT CHILDREN'S LIBRARY.

WHEREAS, Darlene J. Westcott, the Town of Chino Valley's first Children's Librarian, affectionately known throughout the community as "Miss Darlene," has served in that capacity from 1995 through 2018, and has also served as Assistant Librarian and Library Manager; and

WHEREAS, "Miss Darlene" has given generously of her time and talents in establishing a Children's Library Program, as well as developing genuine caring relationships that have impacted many Chino Valley children and families; and

WHEREAS, "Miss Darlene" prepares and presents over 180 programs annually, serving an average of 6,500 children each year, resulting in more than 4,140 programs and 149,500 attendees in her 23 years of service; and

WHEREAS, "Miss Darlene" has been officially recognized for her contributions in the following ways: (i) receiving the Achievement of Civic Excellence Silver Award in 2001; (ii) being named Grand Marshall of the First Territorial Capital Days Parade in 2005; (iii) being inducted into the Heritage Middle School Hall of Fame in 2008; and (iv) receiving the Arizona Youth Services Librarian of the Year award in 2010; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 05-733, adopted on January 13, 2005, created a policy and procedure for naming or renaming parks, facilities, and features, and it is within the criteria of the Resolution to recognize individuals for outstanding service and enhancing the Town's quality of life; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Chino Valley wish to recognize "Miss Darlene" for her tireless efforts to serve the children of Chino Valley.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Chino Valley, Yavapai County, Arizona, as follows:


SECTION 1. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference.




