

RESOLUTION NO. 14-1028

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI,
ARIZONA, EXTENDING THE TERMS OF THE SITTING MAYOR
AND COUNCILMEMBERS TO COMPLY WITH A.R.S. § 16-204,
AS AMENDED, RELATED TO CONSOLIDATED ELECTIONS**

WHEREAS, the Arizona State Legislature in 2012 amended A.R.S. § 16-204 to consolidate all regular candidate elections including those of the Town of Chino Valley, Arizona to the fall of even numbered years; and

WHEREAS, the amendments to A.R.S. § 16-204 consolidate elections beginning in 2014; and

WHEREAS, because of the consolidated elections, the Town of Chino Valley cannot hold elections at the end of the terms of the Mayor and Councilmembers; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with the consolidation of elections, the Town must adjust the length of terms of the Mayor and members of the Town Council currently so that their terms will expire following the General Election in November of even numbered years;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Chino Valley, Arizona, that:

1. The term of Mayor Chris Marley will expire when his successor assumes office following the 2016 election.
2. The terms of those Council Members whose terms expire in the Spring of 2015 will be extended to when their successors assume office following the 2016 election.
3. The terms of those Council Members whose terms expire in the Spring of 2017 will be extended to when their successors assume office following the 2018 election.




