

**RESOLUTION NO. 14-1022**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF  
THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI,  
ARIZONA, DISBANDING THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY  
MAYOR'S AD HOC FLOOD CONTROL COMMITTEE**

**WHEREAS**, on October 25, 2011, the Town of Chino Valley Town Council approved Resolution No. 11-973, establishing the Mayor's Ad Hoc Flood Control Committee for certain purposes related to the researching methods of diversion, retention, and reuse of storm water in the Chino Valley area; and

**WHEREAS**, until the state legislature approves rainwater harvesting on a municipal scale, the Mayor's Ad Hoc Flood Control Committee cannot achieve its purpose;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Chino Valley, County of Yavapai, Arizona, that:

The Town of Chino Valley Mayor's Ad Hoc Flood Control Committee is hereby disbanded and all of its members are relieved of their responsibilities.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution, are hereby repealed.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that is any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.
