

**SCRIVENER'S NOTE:**

*While the form of Resolution No. 14-1043 that was in the Council agenda packet for July 22, 2014 was incorrect, the agenda item provided for the approval of the Statement and Estimates of Expenses for the Chino Valley SLIDs for fiscal year 2014/2015. A public hearing was duly held, after which the Council approved the Resolution with the correct numbers for the Statement and Estimate of Expenses. The subsequent levy and assessment of taxes was adopted based also on the correct numbers. This error was corrected November 17, 2014 and reported to the Council on December 9, 2014.*

**RESOLUTION NO. 14-1043**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA, ADOPTING THE STATEMENTS AND ESTIMATES OF EXPENSES OF THE CHINO VALLEY STREET LIGHTING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICTS, WHICH SHALL CONSTITUTE THE BUDGETS OF THE DISTRICTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015 PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 48-616 AND 42-17101 ET SEQ., ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, AS AMENDED**

WHEREAS, the provisions of A.R.S. § 48-616 require the governing body to levy taxes upon all property in a municipal street lighting improvement district to pay the annual expenses of said districts; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the municipality shall make annual statements and estimates of the expenses of the district, which shall be provided for by the levy and collection of ad valorem taxes upon the assessed value of all the real and personal property in the district, shall publish notice thereof, shall have hearings thereon and adopt said statements and estimates as provided in title 42, chapter 17, article 3 (Sections 42-17101 et seq.), Arizona Revised Statutes; and


WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to approve said statements and estimates for Fiscal Year 2014-2015; and

WHEREAS, public hearings on said statements and estimates of expenses were held on July 8, 2014 and notice of such hearings published in accordance with the requirements of A.R.S. § 48-616;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Chino Valley, County of Yavapai, Arizona, that

1. The Statement and Estimates of Expenses of the Town of Chino Valley, Arizona Street Lighting Improvement Districts for Fiscal Year 2014-2015, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A is hereby approved.
2. Said adopted estimates shall constitute the budgets of the Chino Valley Street Lighting Improvement Districts for Fiscal Year 2014-2015.
