



PROCLAMATION

Summer of Giving - July 12-September 22, 2022

Whereas, over 265 foster youth reside in the Chino Valley and surrounding areas; and

Whereas, foster youth need support meeting basic needs to enrich childhood; and

Whereas, over 3,000 abandoned or abused animals are residing in shelters in the Chino Valley and surrounding area waiting for forever homes; and

Whereas, 435 homebound and isolated elderly in the Quad-Cities are in need of transportation for life's most basic and essential needs; and

Whereas, an increasing proportion of adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities require individualized residential, vocational, and educational long-term care services to lead independent lives in perpetuity throughout the area; and

Whereas, the Town of Chino Valley encourages its citizens and businesses to be a part of the solutions in overcoming obstacles in our community welfare by supporting organizations that help the vulnerable, overlooked, and underserved in Chino Valley and our surrounding areas;

*Now, Therefore, I, Jack W. Miller, Mayor of the Town of Chino Valley, do hereby proclaim July 12-September 22, 2022 as a **Summer of Giving in Chino Valley** including the planned giving competition, which encourages businesses to raise awareness and critical funds for the most vulnerable in our community.*
