

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-1298

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO ARIZONA STATE PARKS AND TRAILS FOR AN OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE RECREATION FUND GRANT FOR THE DESIGN AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE CHINO VALLEY OHV STAGING AREA AT OLD HOME MANOR; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ACTIONS TO COMPLETE THE APPLICATION PROCESS; AND AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF THE GRANT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, Arizona State Parks and Trails (ASPT) administers grant programs that help fund outdoor recreation, educational programs, projects that build recreational motorized and non-motorized trails, trail facilities, and playgrounds; and

WHEREAS, the ASPT Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) Recreation Fund provides financial assistance for the planning, design, and construction of facilities that enhance public safety and access to OHV recreation; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Chino Valley recognizes the importance of providing safe and accessible recreational opportunities for residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the Town applied for grant funding from the OHV Recreation Fund for the design and development of the OHV staging area at Old Home Manor by filing with ASPT an application consistent and compatible with all adopted plans and programs for motorized and non-motorized trails in Arizona.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Chino Valley, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1. The recitals above are incorporated as if fully set forth herein.


SECTION 2. The Town Manager is (i) authorized to apply for and accept grant funding from the OHV Recreation Fund for the design and development of the OHV staging area at Old Home Manor; (ii) directed to comply with all applicable procedures, guidelines, and requirements established by ASPT as part of the application process and with all applicable state and federal regulations, policies, guidelines, and requirements regarding the application; and (iii) appointed as the Town's agent to conduct all negotiations and execute and submit all documents necessary for the completion of the Chino Valley OHV staging area at Old Home Manor.

SECTION 3. The Mayor, Town Manager, and Town Attorney are authorized and directed to execute all documents and take all steps necessary to carry out the purpose and intent of this resolution.

SECTION 4. All actions of the officers and agents of the Town that conform to the purpose and intent of this resolution, whether heretofore or hereafter taken, are hereby ratified, confirmed, and approved.
