WHEREAS, as of October 2, 2012, various municipalities, counties, school districts, colleges and universities, political agencies, and improvement districts have entered into the SAVE Cooperative Purchasing Agreement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. Section 41-2632, the Town is authorized to enter into cooperative purchasing agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Town has determined that it is currently beneficial to the Town to enter into the SAVE Cooperative Purchasing Agreement in order to maximize its purchasing power; and

WHEREAS, the Town may terminate its participation in the SAVE Cooperative Purchasing Agreement upon 30 days' written notice;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Chino Valley, Arizona, that:

 The Town Manager or his designee is directed and authorized to promptly execute and enter into SAVE Cooperative Purchasing Agreement on behalf of the Town. **PASSED AND ADOPTED** by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Chino Valley, Arizona this <u>22nd</u> day of <u>January</u>, 2013.
