### Mary Jane Coulter Volunteerism

The town is currently seeking volunteers to help clean the Fred Harvey Farm property. Other volunteer opportunities are available. Please contact the town for information.

*Mary Jane Coulter was one of the few female American architects of her day. She was the chief architectural designer and interior decorator for the Fred Harvey Company from 1902 – 1948 and designed 21 hotels for Fred Harvey, to include the Hopi House, Lookout Studio, Hermit's Rest, Phantom Ranch and Bright Angel Lodge at the Grand Canyon, La Posada in Winslow, and more. She combined "Mission Revival" style architecture with Indigenous and Spanish influences.*

*When the Fred Harvey Company notice that Indigenous craftspeople were doing a booming trade selling their arts and crafts at railroad stops, they began planning a Hopi House, a dedicated marketplace for Indigenous people at the South Rim of the Grand Canyon.*
