Traffic control changes set at State Route 89 and MacCurdy Road in Prescott Thursday, March 7


Drivers should allow extra travel time and consider an alternate route

The Arizona Department of Transportation advises drivers to plan for the following traffic control changes while new traffic signals are activated at State Route 89 and MacCurdy Road in Prescott:

- The north- and southbound SR 89 traffic signals at MacCurdy Road will be out of service from 9:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. Thursday, March 7. Drivers should consider using Deep Well Ranch Road to Willow Creek Road as an alternate route.
- Law enforcement and flaggers will assist with traffic control.
- A 12-foot vehicle-width restriction will be in place.

Drivers should proceed through the work zone with caution, slow down and watch for construction personnel equipment.
