Stay Home, Stay Healthy, Stay Connected extended to May 15

April 29, 2020

CHINO VALLEY, AZ- In accordance with [Governor Doug Ducey's](#) "Stay Home, Stay Healthy, Stay Connected" order, the Town of Chino Valley will continue to follow the recommendations of both the Governor's office and the [Centers for Disease Control and Prevention](#) until further notice.

The Governor's order, which has been extended through May 15, 2020, limits certain Town services and closed Town buildings to the public, including Town Hall, the Library, and the Community Center.

The Senior Center has been closed to the public but is still providing two meals a day for customers and is still operating the Meals-On-Wheels home delivery service for those in need.

"We will continue to follow the Executive Order from the Governor's office and the guidelines from the CDC and will continue to do all we can to ensure the health and safety of our staff and the community", said Mayor Darryl Croft. "We understand that this pandemic has affected each one of us personally in one way or another, especially our local business community. We want our local businesses to succeed and trust that following these guidelines and expanding services in an appropriate and gradual manner is the best way to do so."

Ducey's office stated in a press conference today a gradual return to "Temporary Normal" with a partial and voluntary reopening of retail businesses beginning on May 4, expanded on May 8, with a hope to re-open dine-in restaurants and other services on May 15, 2020.
