YRMC's free drive through clinic will utilize an FDA-approved nasal swab testing process. Anyone who presents for testing will need to answer a few basic questions and follow a simple registration process. "We want to make this process as simple as possible, but we will need basic information from each person who presents for testing," said Robert Thompson, MD, MBA, Executive Medical Director, YRMC PhysicianCare.

Additional testing dates and locations are being evaluated but no final decisions have been made. "We need to closely monitor our testing supplies to ensure our hospitals and clinical operations can function efficiently during the Pandemic," states Dr. Thompson.
