Town closes lobbies to public

CHINO VALLEY, AZ- Effective July 1, 2020 the Town of Chino Valley will again close the lobbies of Town Hall (202 N Hwy 89 Chino Valley, AZ) and the Public Works Dept. (1982 Voss Dr. Chino Valley, AZ) to the public until further notice.

This is in response to the recent spike in coronavirus/COVID-19 positive test results reported by the [Yavapai County Community Health Services](#) (YCCHS) and in accordance with the [Executive Order](#) released on June 29, 2020 by Governor Doug Ducey.
