



Misdemeanor Classification

Class 1

- Maximum fine \$2500 plus fees and surcharges;
- 6 months in jail
- 3 years probation
- 5 years probation if DUI

Class 2

- Maximum fine \$750 plus fees and surcharges;
- 4 months in jail;
- 2 years probation

Class 3

- Maximum fine \$500 plus fees and surcharges;
- 30 days in jail;
- 1 year probation

PETTY OFFENSE

- Maximum fine \$300
- No jail; no probation

Examples of Misdemeanors

Criminal

- Disorderly conduct
- Assault
- Criminal trespass
- Threatening & intimidating
- Domestic violence
- Open container
- Consuming liquor in public
- Possession of paraphernalia


Criminal Traffic

- Driving under the influence - DUI
- Driving on a suspended license
- Criminal speeding (exceed limit by 21 mph)

Civil Traffic

- Speeding
- Stop sign
- No proof of insurance
- Expired registration
- Talking on cell phone
